“THE SILVER SPOON PRINCE” - BOURGOGNE ROUGE

Pinot Noir is like a silver spoon child; it is hard to grow in the vineyard and even more difficult in the cellar. But if done correctly, it can achieve god-like status, like a prince crowned to king. The best examples are ethereal, utterly complex and beguiling, most of whom are meticulously handcrafted in de Côte de Nuits in Burgundy. Like the Cistercian monks already knew many centuries ago; we also think of Pinot Noir as the noblest of noble and have selected a couple of great examples.
